Furthermore, we would like to stay in touch with you on selected topics by E-Mail. For this, we process your E-Mail address and (if voluntary indicated) your telephone number.

For the Virtual Meetup Series we collaborate with our external service Provider Go2Meeting (LogMeIn Ireland Ltd, 10 Hanover Quay, Dublin 2, D02R73 Ireland).

Simultaneously, ROSEN takes protection of your personal related data, and especially your pictures and video recordings, seriously but points out, that these recordings are accessible worldwide if published in the internet.

### Legal basis of the data processing

The legal basis for taking video and audio recordings is our legitimate interest according to article 6, paragraph 1, lit. f of the European General Data Protection Regulation (EU-GDPR), respectively your consent according to article 6 paragraph 1 lit. a EU-GDPR.

### Retention Periods

Your voluntary indicated contact Data are being processed until you revoke your consent to the below mentioned contact address. Upon the date of the Virtual Meetup Series takes place, your personal data will be stored for a duration of one year and will be deleted automatically afterwards.

### Responsible body and your rights against us:

Responsible person in terms of article 4 no.7 EU-GDPR is the ROSEN Technology and Research Center GmbH, am Seitenkanal 8, 49811 Lingen/Ems. You have the following rights against us with regard to personal data concerning your person:

- **Right for information:**  
According to article 15 of EU-GDPR you're entitled to ask what personal data are being stored at us, what the purpose of the processing is, what categories of personal data are being processed, to which recipients or categories of recipients your personal data are disclosed, what the duration of the data processing is or if not determined precisely what the criteria for a storage duration are, your rights in regard of correction, erasure and limitation of processing of your personal data, your right to complain about the data processing at the responsible data protection authority and if not raised personally from you the source where the personal data of you were raised as well as if automated decision making applies.
- **Right to correction or deletion:**

If your personal data are wrong, according to article 16 of EU-GDPR you're entitled to request a correction of your personal data.

- **Right for Erasure:**  
According to article 17 of EU-GDPR you're entitled to request deletion of your personal data.
- **Right to limitation of processing:**  
According to article 18 of EU-GDPR you're entitled to request a limitation of the processing so far if the legitimacy of the processing is doubtful.
- **Right to data transferability:**  
According to article 20 of EU-GDPR you're entitled to request that you receive your personal data in a structured, common and machine readable data format in order to transfer them towards another responsible person.
- **Right to disagree the processing:**  
According to Article 21 of EU-GDPR and depending on the specific situation, you're entitled to disagree against processing of your personal data at any time.
- **Right to complain**  
You are entitled to complain at a data protection supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data in our company, such as the data protection supervisory authority responsible for us, in accordance with Art. 77 EU-GDPR:
